# THE CARE YOU NEED. IN THE COMFORTS OF YOUR OWN HOME.

Whether recovering from illness, surgery or accident, receiving the expertise of skilled care providers in the comforts of your home is the service Kline Galland Home Health provides.

With outstanding service and authentic caring at the core of our purpose, our team of nurses, therapists, social workers and home health aides is committed to helping you reach your highest level of health and function. You become the center of the care team, participating in goal setting and care planning.

## INITIATING HOME HEALTH SERVICES

To be eligible for home health services, Medicare (and most insurance agencies) require you meet certain requirements, and have an order from a physician. To qualify you must:

- Be homebound-this means that it takes considerable amount of effort to leave your home, or that you require assistance to leave the home.
- Have a face-to-face encounter with your physician-either 90 days prior to the start of home health services, or within 30 days after the start of home health services.
- Require the skilled services of a nurse or therapist that are intermittent. (Home Health does not provide care you 24 hours per day, nor does it cover homemaker services such as house cleaning, errands or chore services.

## COLLABORATION AND TEAMWORK.

Depending on your specific needs, you may require services of one discipline, or our full team:

- · Skilled Nursing
- Physical Therapy
- · Occupational Therapy
- Speech Therapy

## YOUR KLINE GALLAND CARE TEAM.

Our hospice care is coordinated by a highly trained interdisciplinary team:

- Physician who collaborates with the patient's primary care physician to manage the care plan, control pain and symptoms.
- Case Manager who is a Registered Nurse and is skilled in assessing and managing pain, and other end-of-life symptoms.
- After Hours Registered Nurse for when you have questions, or there are changes in condition overnight that require urgent attention.
- LPNs (Licensed Practical Nurse) who often assist with patient home visits, providing care and aid to patients in the comfort of their homes.
- Home Health Aide who can help with bathing and dressing; personal care, including hair, skin, oral and nails.
- Social Worker who provides emotional and psychosocial support, along with identify needs for additional resources.
- Speech Therapist who provides one-on-one care designed to help manage or treat issues related to language, difficulty swallowing, or help overcome cognitive difficulties that affect the ability to communicate.
